
## Chapter 201

But he didn't expect Leo to achieve his goal so fast.


It only took him a few days to convince Mayor Lee.

Liam, on the other hand, had no expression and said nothing.


At this moment, the door opened and two people came in, attracting the attention of all the audience.

Abigail didn't like parties at all, but she had no choice but to participate again and again, with her exhusband Liam and current chaser Leo.


Leo was her mentor and had given her a lot of help. Therefore, when he had returned to develop his own career here and asked her to be his companion, she knew she had to help him.
