Liam and Abigail had already married, but the fact had been well hidden!


But why would Mr. Jones still be with Olive if he was truly married to Abigail?

Abigail sat there calmly and looked at Jacob's angry face, and she knew that he was worried about her. Only after Jacob finished her words did she speak.


